May/June 2021

The pestilence continues here in Korea. However, the work goes on! Covid is bad but for Joy and I watching our people leave is worse. Since our last letter we have had two more families rotate out. I have been a missionary to the military for 22 years and the pain of see our people leave never gets any better. That is just part of the military ministry.



We had been praying for many months that the Lord would provide someone else to play the piano. For a good while now Joy was the only one who could play. We have also been praying for someone to fill the pulpit for me. Every year we must make a short trip to the U. S. to fulfill Joy's immigration requirements. Without God providing the necessary people the trip would be impossible. We had to go in June. God never fails! In May a young Airman came and joined the church and guess what, he plays the piano! We still needed a preacher. Well, also in May a new Missionary family arrived in Korea and just happened to have the time to fill the pulpit for me! Ain't God good!



In May our school finished the school year. Again, the Lord blessed as we were able to keep the school open for the entire school year. The kindergarten children in Joys class were amazing kids. Each one of them learned to read, do beginner level arithmetic and more importantly they each memorized 15 Bible verses. Everyone of those children new the gospel and how to share it! Parents were contacting us, sharing their amazement of all that their children had learned. It's incredible how the word has spread about Victory Baptist Academy. Parents are contacting us before they even arrive in country with a desire to register their children. To God be the glory!



In June I climbed another rung on the age ladder. It's hard to believe that I'm 63 years old! The day after my birthday we flew to the USA. But not before getting another Covid test. The flight is 14 hours long and we were required to wear a mask the entire way! However, it was a blessing to spend time in our home church, and 2 of our local supporting churches.
