I would like to start off by thanking all of you for the very generous Christmas gifts you sent. You are a blessing to us!



During the 2 years of Covid-19 our church remained completely free from any sickness until 2022 began. The year started for us with 11 case of Covid-19 in just 2 of our families. Then we had five of our preschool students develop symptoms. All of them test positive! This caused us to close down the school to prevent further sickness. Joy and I both managed to stay healthy; however, we were forced to take the church back to on-line services until we both received negative PCR tests. Fortunately, that only lasted one service! It was long until everyone was healthy again and all of our folks were back in church. Two weeks after all of the school children returned, 9 students went down with a different virus. Once again the Lord protected me and Joy! Currently, the church and the school are both healthy and doing well!



It is sad and disgusting to see what our senior government leadership has allowed our military to become. The character and the discipline that made our military the most powerful fighting force in the world is being eroded way.
